- 2. Conveners/Representatives of the Sectoral Group may be invited whenever considered necessary when projects of that sector are being discussed.
- 3. The Standing Committee will deal with the following aspects:
 - (i) Evaluation, Prioritization and Selection of appropriate technologies for production of replacement chemicals as different applications and trial including improvement and dissemination of such technologies.
 - (ii) Evaluation of proposals for modernization, upgrading of equipment, supporting manpower and services.
 - (iii) Identifying technologies and equipment/components and chemical materials, which are locally available and potentially available and suggesting the manner in which they can be used for self-sufficiency.
 - (iv) Involvement of research institutions/universities including in-house R&D setups in private sector, research groups and consultancy engineering design organizations with a view to develop indigenous capabilities.
 - (v) Fiscal measures of promotion and development of technology, determining costs, etc.
 - (vi) This Standing Committee will also recommend the panel of Indian consultants who will help the enterprises in preparing the project proposals.
- 4. The Standing Committee will continuously look at implementation of the Montreal Protocol and may co-opt other experts.

- 5. The period of the Committee will be valid for 3 years w.e.f the date of issue of the office order.
- 6. The expenditure towards travel and sitting fee to the non-official members will be paid as per rules.
